Friday, November 30, 2018



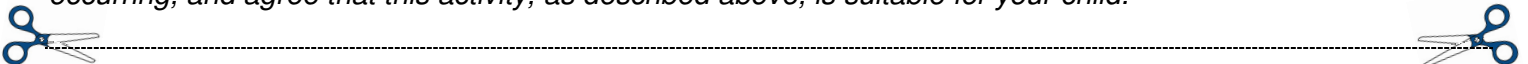
We have arranged a field trip for Home Quest students and parents on Friday, November 30, 2018 to see “**A Charlie Brown Holiday Double Bill**” at the Carousel Theatre on Granville Island (1411 Cartwright Street, Vancouver, BC). Families are asked to arrive by **9:15 am** as our entire group must be present before we can be seated. Theatre staff will begin seating groups at 9:30 am.

Experience the ups and downs of everyday life with Charlie Brown and his friends in “You’re A Good Man Charlie Brown”. It’s just a series of typical days but when your friends are the Peanuts gang, no day is ever ordinary and no event is too small to ponder. And somewhere between Beethoven’s Birthday, peanut butter sandwiches, and the existential merits of a Peter Rabbit book report, Charlie Brown and the gang stumble upon the true meaning of happiness. Then join Charlie Brown in “A Charlie Brown Christmas” as he tries to direct his friends in the school Christmas pageant. With help from his friends and a ragged little tree, Charlie Brown discovers what the season is really all about.

We will be traveling by Parents’ Private Vehicles to Carousel Theatre. It can sometimes be challenging to find a parking space at Granville Island so plan to get there early. Students will meet at 9:15 am and the performance is approximately 80 minutes long with no intermission. Immediately following the play, actors will remain on stage for a 5-10 minute post-show talk.

Due to a restricted number of seats, tickets are for enrolled Home Quest students and may include one parent, as well. If additional seats are requested, we will put you on a waitlist. Home Quest families will have two weeks to reserve seats before we open up the waitlist. Per Carousel Theatre, this performance is for students in Kindergarten and up (children not yet in Kindergarten and babes in arms will not be admitted.) Please let us know 48 hours in advance for any cancellations to avoid being charged for your reserved tickets.
